Villa Savoye, known as *Les Heures Claires* ('The Light Hours'), is an internationally renowned masterpiece built by architect Charles-Edouard Jeanneret, known as Le Corbusier, and Pierre Jeanneret between 1928 and 1931.

This weekend villa, commissioned by Mr and Mrs Savoye, is now considered an iconic work of modern architecture.

DID YOU KNOW...?

There are no load-bearing walls at the Villa Savoye, which sits on slab-columns that Le Corbusier called the Dom-ino system.
